## Language Arts

<u>Continuing Establishing Routines in Reading</u> and Writing and Storytelling

## Math

Compose and Decompose numbers Up to 10 Students compose and decompose numbers up to 10 with objects and picture. They will be modeling their understanding of addition as joining and subtracting by practicing composing and decomposing numbers.

Vocabulary: whole, part, symbols, equal

#### Mapping Skills

Students will learn the tools of a geographer and how to use those skills to determine relevant location. They will understand the meaning of directional words.

<u>Vocabulary</u>: over, under, near, far, left, right, map, globe, location

### Science

#### Heating and Cooling

Students will be able to understand that material can be changed by heating and cooling.

<u>Vocabulary</u>: hot, cold, melt, freeze, heating, cooling, observe, record
